LINKSter’s Release New Scoring App!

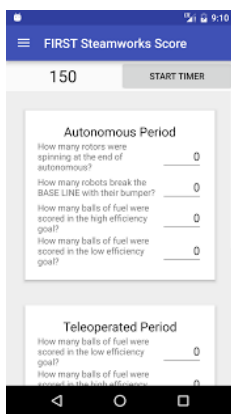
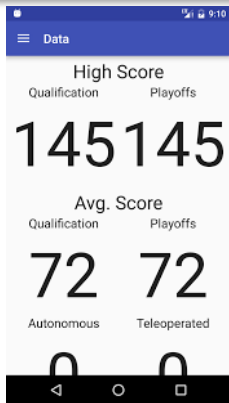


This month, Fernbank LINKS released the FRC Score app for the 2017 game, FIRST STEAMWORKS, on the Google Play Store.

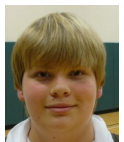
Team Spotlight
